

Interested in starting a Highs School or Collegiate Affiliate?

Here are some steps to follow.

- Obtain the contact information for a Catholic High School or College
- Contact the NCCW Office with this information.
- The NCCW Office will provide instructions on how to proceed using the steps noted below in *To Form a Council at a School*. It is important that you first contact the NCCW Office prior to approaching a school.

TO FORM A COUNCIL AT A SCHOOL

- 1. Secure the approval of the administration
- 2. Find a mentor for the affiliate who is familiar or ideally a member of Council
- 3. Meet with the mentor to review Council mission, history, programs and her role
- 4. Mentor submits affiliate information (contact information, membership, dues) to National
- 5. Mentor obtains a Spiritual Advisor for the affiliate
- 6. Mentor sets up an information session that may be held in conjunction with a Mass, Prayer service, or service project
- 7. High School Girls and Collegiate Women sign up as Individual Members (\$5 annually for High School and \$10 annually for colleges)
- 8. Optional: Elections are held to name a President, President-Elect, Treasurer, and Secretary
- 9. Affiliate work is based on one or more of the National resolutions and available programs and they can also develop their own projects.
