

2020 NCCW Our Lady of Good Counsel Award

The National Council of Catholic Women's **Our Lady of Good Counsel Award** recognizes significant and outstanding contributions made by a council woman in the areas of service to the Church, the Council of Catholic Women, her parish, and the community at large.

AWARD CRITERIA

Nominees should meet the following criteria:

- A woman who has made a significant contribution on the diocesan, deanery/subdivision, parish, or national level of NCCW;
- A woman who has served as an outstanding role model of service to others;
- A woman who has shown exemplary leadership and made significant contributions to the mission, vision, and programs of NCCW;
- A woman whose life reflects the Gospel values of justice and peace;
- A woman who supports the gift of a multi-cultural church and who enables others to share their gifts in their council work;
- A woman who serves as a model of collaboration with others in her diocese, subdivision or parish; and

Nominations should have the support of the diocesan council. The nominee must be an NCCW individual or Supporting member actively involved in council and council work. Nominees may be re-submitted in subsequent years. **Members currently serving on the National Board of Directors are ineligible.**

NOMINATION DEADLINES AND SELECTION PROCESS

Nominations open: Monday, March 9, 2020. The nomination package should be sent directly to the NCCW office via email or regular mail and received by close of business April 24, 2020. No admissions will be accepted after this date. **EVERYTHING REQUIRED MUST BE SUBMITTED TOGETHER IN ONE MAILING.** Note: nominations sent via email will necessitate scanning reference letters.

Selection process: Only those serving on the NCCW OLGC Award Selection Committee will review nominations and will select the award recipient of the 2020 NCCW Our Lady of Good Counsel Award. A blind review process will be used with each nomination package assigned a number. The identity of the nominee will remain anonymous during the selection process; therefore, the nominee's name must only be used on the cover sheet of the application. Throughout the application, please use only pronouns or "our nominee" or "the nominee" etc. The NCCW OLGC Award Selection Committee will review and select the award recipient. The Chair will report directly to the NCCW President. The NCCW President will notify the person who prepared the nomination package of the winner. That person will decide if the winner is to be notified before the award presentation. Consideration should be given as to who would like to be present for the award presentation. The OLGC Award will be presented at the Awards Breakfast at the 2020 NCCW Convention on Friday, August 28, 2020. This event is part of the Full Convention Registration.

The Award recipient will be recognized in the NCCW Connect and in the Catholic Woman magazine following convention.

Award presentation: The award will be presented at the **NCCW 2020 Annual Convention**. The award recipient will also be recognized in the monthly e-newsletter NCCW CONNECT, on the NCCW website and in the Catholic Woman magazine following the presentation at convention.

- 1. How has the nominee shown exemplary leadership and made significant contributions to the mission and programs of NCCW?
- 2. How does the nominee's life reflect the Gospel values?
- 3. How has the nominee supported the spiritual and leadership development of other council leaders and been an outstanding mentor to future leaders in Council?
- 4. How has the nominee shown collaboration with others in her diocese, deanery/subdivision or parish?
- 5. The Church in the United States is multicultural. How has the nominee embraced and promoted acceptance and inclusion of all cultures in any level of Council?
- 6. What would the nominee consider her most outstanding contribution to the National Council of Catholic Women at any level of Council?
- 7. How would the nominee say that belonging to the National Council of Catholic Women has enriched her life?
