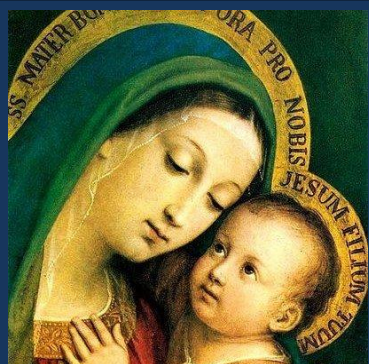
### *Celebrating 100 Years as a Unified Voice!*

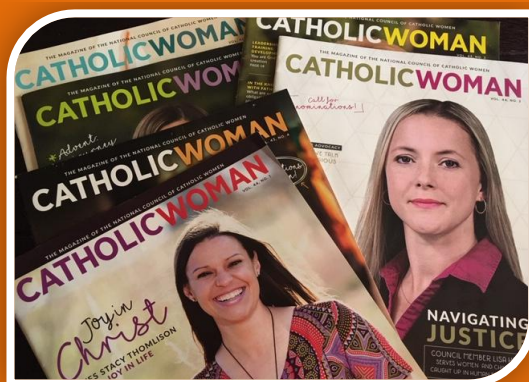

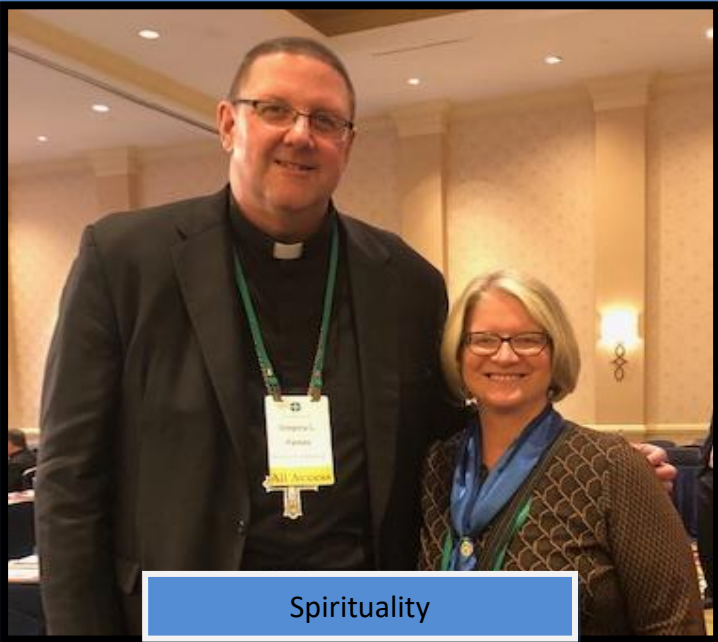
