

Call for Bylaw Amendments 2021

Like any thriving organization, the National Council of Catholic Women periodically amends or revises its bylaws to serve better its membership and the mission of the organization. Each year at our annual convention proposed bylaws amendments are voted on by attending Individual Members and Affiliation Delegates. Although our convention is not until August, the Bylaws amendment process begins now.

Any NCCW affiliation or subdivision president or any three (3) Individual Members may propose amendments to the NCCW Bylaws. Proposed amendments are reviewed by the Bylaws Committee and are then presented to the NCCW Board of Directors for consideration at its spring meeting. Notice of the proposed amendments approved by the Board is sent to all affiliation presidents, subdivision presidents, and individual members **forty-five (45) days** in advance of our annual convention.

To allow for the Bylaws Committee and Board of Directors sufficient time to consider amendments for voting at our 2021 convention, proposed amendments using the Bylaw Amendment Form must be received by the Bylaws Committee Chair no later than April 1, 2021.
