Opening Prayer:

Hail Mary, poor and humble Woman, Blessed by the Most High! Virgin of hope, dawn of a new era, we join in your song of praise, to celebrate the Lord's mercy, to proclaim the coming of the Kingdom and the full liberation of humanity.

First Joyful Mystery: The Annunciation. Fruit of the Mystery- Humility

"Mary said, "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word." [Luke 1:38]

Third Joyful Mystery The Nativity of the Lord.

Fruit of the Mystery- Poverty of the Spirit, Detachment from the Things of this World "When the angels went away from them to heaven, the shepherds said to one another, 'Let us go, then, to Bethlehem to see this thing that has taken place, which the Lord has made known to us.' So they went in haste and found Mary and Joseph, and the infant lying in the manger. When they saw this, they made known the message that had been told them about this child. All who heard it were amazed by what had been told them by the shepherds. And Mary kept all these things, reflecting on them in her heart." [Luke 2: 15-19]

Gracious Mother, you had just given birth to the Son of God in a cave and now strangers wanted to see your son. You welcomed them with a serene smile. Help me greet those who demand things from me with serenity and grace.

Fourth Joyful Mystery: Presentation in the Temple. Fruit of the Mystery- Obedience

"The child's father and mother were amazed at what was said about him and Simeon blessed them and said to Mary his mother, 'Behold, this child is destined for the fall and rise of many in Israel, and to be a sign that will be contradicted (and you yourself a sword will pierce) so that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed." [Luke 2: 33-35]

Obedient Mother, was there a voice in your head that told you to take your baby son and flee when Simeon spoke? How often do I want to just turn around and hide from my responsibilities? Help me to be obedient to God's call, no matter where I am and what I need to do.

Fifth Joyful Mystery: Finding the Child Jesus in the Temple. Fruit of the Mystery- Piety

"And he said to them, 'Why were you looking for me? Did you not know that I must be in my Father's house?' But they did not understand what he said to them. He went down with them and came to Nazareth, and was obedient to them; and his mother kept all these things in her heart." [Luke 2: 49-51]

Patient Mother, I'm sure Jesus was not a disobedient child. But you still had to provide guidance to him and then he had disappeared for three days; this child placed in your care by God, our heavenly Father. My concerns in this world sometimes feel overwhelming. Open my heart to God's guidance to understand what He needs me to do and the fortitude to finish what needs to be done.
