Fruit of the Mystery: Faith

In keeping with his promises at the Last Supper, Christ prepares a place for each of us in His Father’s Kingdom, giving us the hope of eternal life. “And when I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw everyone to myself,” said the Lord.
