# 2025 NCCW Convention – August 19 -23 in Orlando, Florida

#### **Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament**

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will be offered on Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday from 7:00 to 8:00 a.m. in the Meditation Room in the Grand Ballroom VI.

# **Allergies (fragrance)**

According to NCCW Standing Rules, Section II Meetings, 7. Meeting Agenda, (g) Allergies, "All in-person board meetings shall observe no smoking and shall be fragrance free in meeting and common areas." This means no perfumes are to be used at Convention, and heavily fragranced personal care items should be avoided if possible.

#### **Awards Luncheon**

The Awards Luncheon is open to all attendees and is a ticketed event. Your ticket will be in the packet you receive at registration. The Luncheon to honor the Our Lady of Good Counsel Award recipient and our National Golden Rose Award will be held on Friday in the main Grand Ballroom.

# **Banquet Ticket Information**

If you registered for the banquet, your ticket will be in the packet you receive at registration. No one can be admitted to the banquet without a ticket. There will be open seating except for reserved tables in the front of the room for sponsors and guests. A reception with a cash bar will be held before the banquet.

# **Convention Photography**

Convention Photography Services, Inc. has covered NCCW Conventions for almost 25 years. Photos taken will be on display the same day or the following day. Display tables with the photos will be available through Sunday morning in the foyer on the way to the main lobby.

#### **Convention Protocols**

- Special seating is reserved at the General Sessions for Past Presidents and our invited guests.
- At the Annual Business Meeting, reserved seating is set up for voting members who are requested to be in their seats 5 minutes before the opening of the meeting.
- Except for the above two sessions, seating at all other times is on a first-come basis. The saving of seats is **limited to 2 seats**. Please be welcoming and encourage new friends to join your tables.
- Cell phones must be turned off or set to vibrate at all sessions, Convention events, and liturgies.

# **Emergencies**

In the event of an emergency, please use the hotel's house phone to dial 911. After your call, please notify the front desk and the NCCW Staff.

#### **Exhibits**

Exhibits and vendors are located in the South Ballroom, and exhibits from our Convention Sponsors are displayed in the Grand Foyer, immediately outside the Grand Ballroom. Please see the daily schedule in this program for the times the exhibits are open. We encourage you to visit the exhibitors and thank them for their support of the National Council of Catholic Women.

#### **First Timers Orientation**

If this is your first time attending the Convention, be sure to attend the orientation on Wednesday at 5:30 p.m., immediately following our opening session. You will learn about all things Convention, get to make some new friends, and have a bit of fun.

#### **Food**

Two meals are included as part of your Convention registration: the continental breakfast on Thursday morning before departure to the Shrine and our Friday night FUNdraiser (more on that below). For meals on your own, our hotel offers dining options on-site. There are also plenty of nearby restaurants in the Disney Springs entertainment district.

Your Orlando hostesses are wearing yellow sashes with blue lettering that identifies them as such. You will find our hostesses at the Orlando information booth, located near the entrance of our Convention area, and throughout the Conference. They will be happy to assist you and welcome you to the Sunshine State.

The NCCW is delighted to announce that Magnify of Central Florida is our 2025 Convention charity. We will be collecting funds to support this ministry throughout our event and will also share a Mass collection with them. #### **Lost and Found**
